Units 1 and 2 pulled into the driveway of Centerra, 6701 Wooster Pike Road. Unit 1 came to a stop, and Unit 2 attempted to pass Unit 1 on the right side within the driveway. As Unit 2 was passing, the driver of Unit 2 turned too sharply to the left, causing the driver's side fender of Unit 2 to strike the front passenger-side bumper of Unit 1. The collision resulted in minor damage to both vehicles. Photographs of the damage were taken, and no injuries were reported.
